Punjabi language, which may be specified by the Government from time to time on or before the last date of submission of Application Forms.

Candidates should not be below 21 years and above 37 years of age as on January 01, except the posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police and Deputy Superintendent Jails/District Probation Officers.

For the posts of Deputy Superintendent of Police and Deputy Superintendent Jails/District Probation Officers, the candidates should not be below 21 years and above 28 years of age.
